



**Soap Donation Center, Inc.
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Press Release April 17, 2024

Founded in 2022, Soap Donation Center is a new nonprofit local to San Diego County. It is the charity's mission to collect homemade soap and distribute it throughout the United States to tax-exempt charities and those in need so they may benefit from improved hygiene and quality of life. Soap Donation Center was formed because charities each prefer different types of soap. For example, the burn survivor organization wants soap that does not contain fragrances or colorants, while shelters often request small bars of soap to reduce waste.

Soap Donation Center board members and volunteers run the organization from their homes. A commercial soap manufacturer donated 400 pallets of new, unused bar soap to the organization, which cannot store the daunting quantity of soap. The 1 million bars must be transported in 14 big rig semitrailers.

Even though each truck must be unloaded all at once in one location, multiple trucks are available to deliver a truck-load of soap to different locations. Ideally, each truck would unload 22 pallets onto a loading dock. If a dock is not available, a forklift is needed to move the pallets.

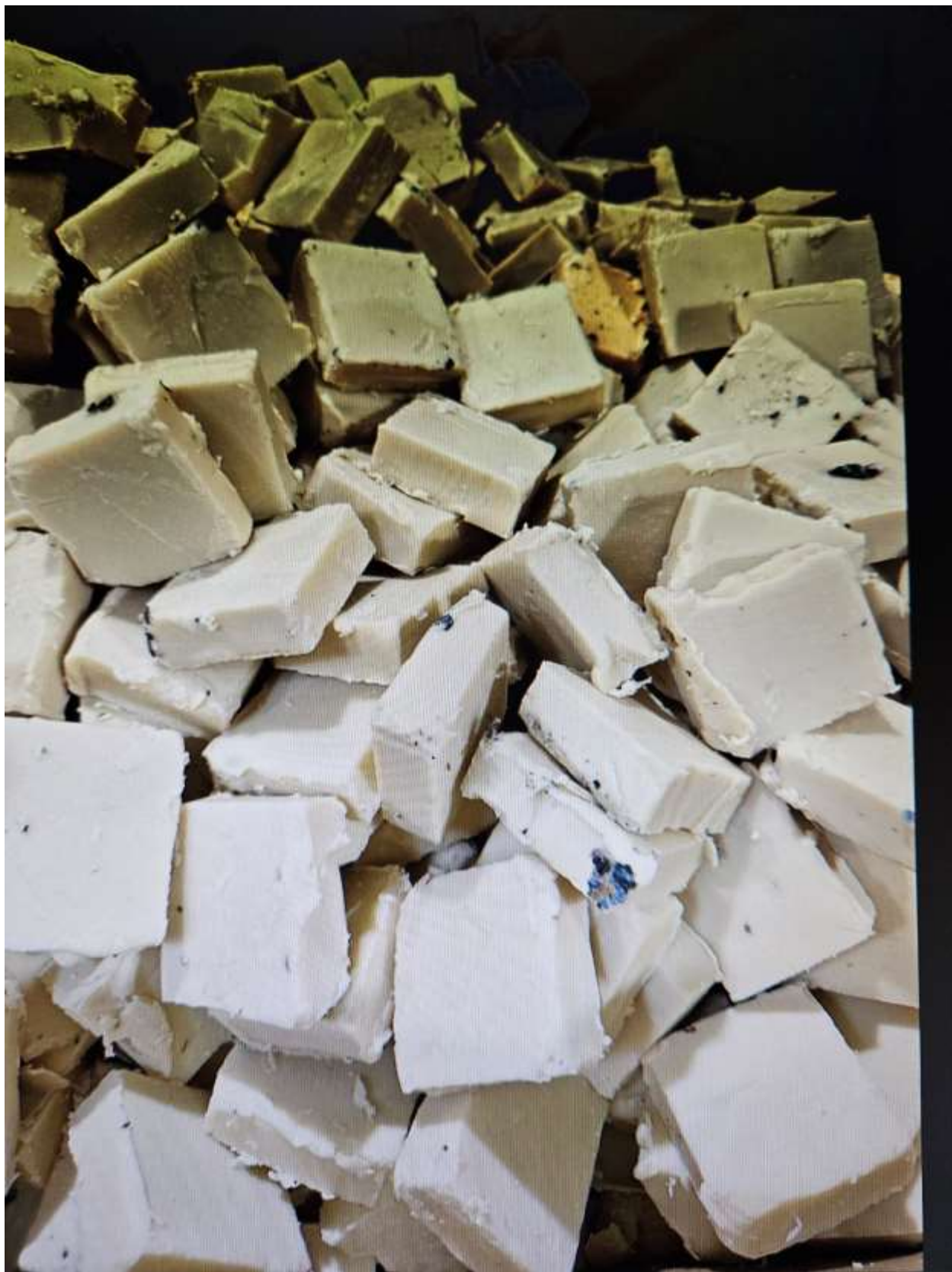
